- Have completed at least 60 undergraduate credits at the time of application
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA, or permission from your undergraduate Division Director or Department Chair
- Submit a completed Application to Enroll and a completed Graduate Application by March 1 for priority consideration to begin taking graduate courses in the fall semester or by October 1 for priority consideration to begin taking graduate courses in the spring semester
- Maintain a 3.0 minimum GPA while in the BS/MS Option
