RECOMMENDED DEADLINES

Stevenson's Admissions Office reviews applications on a rolling basis throughout the year for all majors except Nursing and Medical Technology (see website for more information). However, the University strongly encourages students to follow the recommended deadlines listed below.

Send check or money order payable to Stevenson University. Apply online or submit proof of Phi Theta Kappa or other college honors program or society membership, and the application fee is waived.
- College Transcript(s)
Submit official college transcript(s) from each college or university attended. A final transcript must be sent upon completion of any coursework in progress. Official transcripts from students who have completed coursework outside the United States must be evaluated by either World Education Services <wes.org> or American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admission Officers <aacrao.org>.

- High School Transcript or GED
If you have earned fewer than 30 college-level credits, submit your official high school or GED transcript.

- Permanent Residents
Applicants who currently hold a Permanent Resident card must submit a photocopy of the front and back of the card.
