## STAR Transfer Plan Community College of Baltimore County Theatre and Media Performance

This transfer plan is intended for students pursuing an **Associate of Arts in Theatre** from the Community College of Baltimore County who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Theatre and Media Performance at Stevenson University. The equivalencies below demonstrate how a student can meet both the requirements of the associate degree and prepare for a seamless transfer to Stevenson. Stevenson participates in reverse transfer should students transfer after completing 15 credits at CCBC but before completing the full associate's degree. Please note:

- Only courses that have course equivalencies are displayed. This guide does not show all transferable courses from this college. It also does not display all Stevenson University courses that will fulfill a specific requirement.
- All program requirements must be completed and students must earn a minimum of 120 credits to earn a bachelor's degree. Program requirements must be completed with a grade of C or better, and general education courses must be completed with a grade of D or better.

<sup>4</sup> History courses fulfill the Social and Behavioral Sciences requirement at CCBC but do not fulfill the Social Sciences requirement at Stevenson; instead, history classes fulfill Stevenson's Humanities requirement.

## Theatre and Media Performance

Students who have earned an **Associate of Arts in Theater from the Community College of Baltimore County** will transfer up to 70 credits to Stevenson toward a BS in Theatre and Media Performance as a block without the need for a course-by-course match, and their general education requirements will be considered complete. Students will need to complete the courses listed below and reach a minimum of 120 credits.
