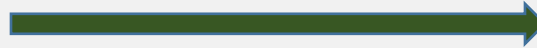


## SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE OPTIONS

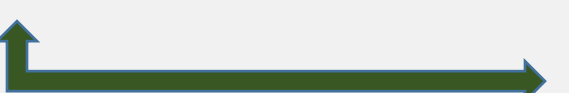
