As you've seen in Dr. Hirshman's email, SU will be extending online instruction through Saturday, April 4th. We are writing to update you on how Residence Life and Housing will support you during this time. As indicated in that communication, if you have to remain in or return to the residence halls during the remote instruction period, please complete the [Check In Form](#) as soon as possible, but no later than Thursday, March 19, 2020.

We recognize that there may be a variety of personal or academic reasons why students may have to remain in, or return to, the campus residences during the period of remote instruction. We ask that you complete the form so that we can maintain accurate information about who may be present in the halls during that time.

There are a number of reasons that may influence your decision to return or remain away from campus while classes are held remotely. Please note the following:
