

Fall 2022 International Student Course Registration FAQ

Some international students residing in specific countries may have difficulty accessing some of SU's online services that are necessary to progress through the new student course registration process. In order to facilitate the registration process prior to these students arriving on campus, the Office of Student Success has developed this FAQ sheet to help navigate some common concerns.

What services are impacted by these restrictions?

Most online SU services will be impacted. Incoming students may not be able to activate their SU Single Sign On, and therefore would not have access to most of their online services.

When will I be able to access SU's online services?

International students should have access to SU's online services and the ability to activate their SU Single Sign On when they arrive in the US and/or another country that is not on the restricted countries list.

Course Registration

How will I register for classes?

The Office of Student Success will facilitate your course registration process. Students who are unable to activate their SU Single Sign On should reach out to NewStudentRegistraton@stevenson.edu for specific instructions and follow up regarding course registration. OSS will schedule individual advising and registration appointments for all students who are unable to complete our online academic orientation. Students will need to provide written acknowledgement that OSS will be processing their registration and a bill will be generated in the student's name.

How can I take my math placement assessment?

A special cohort has been developed in the ALEKS Math Placement Assessment system for international students who do not have access to their Single Sign On. Students will need to create an account at www.aleks.com and will need the international student class code. The code will be provided when students reach out to NewStudentRegistration@stevenson.edu.

When will I register for classes?

Course registration for new students typically begins mid-June. The Office of Student Success will reach out to you to schedule a time to register for classes after you've finished your placement assessments.

What if I want to make changes to my schedule after I register?

As with any new student, you will need to reach out to the Office of Student Success to make adjustments to your schedule.
