



- **Can I use financial aid for international & off campus study?**
 - Yes! You can use scholarships, grants, and loans for international & off campus study. Institutional and Maryland State aid can be used during the Fall and Spring terms. Any institutional aid you have will be applied in one of three categories (100%, 50% or 0%). Federal grants and loans are dependent on remaining annual eligibility and can be used for any term. Private loans and scholarships can be used for any term up to the budgeted costs for your chosen program.
- **What do I need to do to receive financial aid?**
 - For federal and state aid, you must submit a Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov for the academic year you intend to study abroad. For Fall and Spring semester programs, your aid will automatically be adjusted. For Winterim, Summer or any short-term program (spring break), contact the financial aid office.
- **How can I find out what types and amounts of aid I am eligible for?**
 - Contact the financial aid office with the program you are interested in participating in.
