### INFORMATION FOR: MLT(ASCP)<sup>CM</sup> CCBC / AACC TRANSFER

THIS APPLICATION IS FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE GRADUATED WITH AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE FROM THE MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY (MLT) PROGRAM AT ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR THE COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF BALTIMORE COUNTY AND WISH TO COMPLETE A BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE (MLS). **APPLYING FOR ADMISSION TO STEVENSON UNIVERSITY IS A SEPARATE PROCESS FROM APPLYING TO THE MLS PROGRAM.**

1. Stevenson University has an articulation agreement with these institutions for transfer of credits, but this does not guarantee admission to the University or to the MLS program.
2. All MLT transfer students must first be accepted into Stevenson University before consideration by the Medical Laboratory Science Admissions Committee.
3. Applications to the University and to the MLS Program may be submitted concurrently. **Please note:** The University needs enough time to act on your application for admission to the University *prior to* consideration by the MLS Admissions Committee.
4. Substitution of medical laboratory technician courses (MLT or MLTC) for equivalent Medical Laboratory Science (MLS) courses, as stated in the articulation agreement, will only be allowed if the MLT graduate is ASCP-BOC certified and documentation is provided.
5. Contact the director of your MLT program for details of what courses will/ will not transfer and the tentative curricular plan for MLT(ASCP)<sup>CM</sup> transfer students.
6. If the applicant has completed the MLT program at AACC or CCBC, but is not ASCP-certified, he/she may be accepted to the University as a Transfer Student. See *Application for Admission for Transfer Students*.
7. A complete *Application for Admission*, including personal statement, 2 recommendations, official transcripts and *Courses in Progress Form* (if applicable) **must be received no later than March 1. Incomplete file will not be processed.**
