This transfer plan is intended for students pursuing an Associate Applied Science in Computer Graphics at Carroll Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Graphic Design, General Track at Stevenson University. Stevenson participates in reverse transfer should students transfer after completing 15 credits at Carroll but before completing the full associate's degree. Please note:

- Program requirements must be completed with a grade of C or better, and general education courses must be passed with a grade of D or better.
