If Stevenson University Financial Aid Office approved you for a Dependency Override in the previous school year, you are eligible to have that status re-evaluated. You must still be a student who is in a degree seeking program at Stevenson University. You must also complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA, leaving parent information blank and answering NO to all Student Dependency Questions. For federal aid purposes, an independent student is someone who can answer YES to any one of the following:

- Born before January 1, 1997
- Living with legal guardian as determined by a court of law
- Emancipated minor as determined by a court of law
- Deemed at risk of homelessness
- Married as of the date you filed your 2020-2021 FAFSA
- Working on a master's or doctorate program
- Have children and will provide more than half support between July 1, 2020, and June 30, 2021
- Presently live with dependents other than children or a spouse, and will provide more than half support through June 30, 2021
- Orphan, foster child, or ward of the court (until age 18)
- Veteran of the armed forces
- Currently serving on active duty in the U.S. armed forces

Please provide us with the following information and complete this form so that we may re-evaluate your dependency.

1. Submit an updated personal statement letter of explanation; including relationship with parents, where you live and specific financial information detailing how you support yourself.
2. If you filed taxes, you may complete IRS Data Retrieval through the FAFSA or provide us with a copy of your 2018 Federal IRS Tax Return Transcript. To access and print an official IRS Tax Transcript go to www.irs.gov and under the "Tools" menu select "Get Transcript for My Tax Returns".

OR

In the event that you did not file taxes, you will need to complete and submit a 2020-2021 Independent Student Non-Tax Filer Form and request (via IRS Form 4506-T) an IRS Verification of Non-Filing Letter. The Non-Tax Filer Form.

3. Complete and submit a 2020-2021 Independent Student Household Worksheet found on the Stevenson University Financial Aid Website under FORMS.
4. When you complete your 2020-2021 FAFSA, leave parental information blank and answer NO to all Student Dependency Questions. This will cause your FAFSA to be rejected.

If requested, I agree to provide further documentation to substantiate the information provided. I understand all dependency override decisions are made on a case-by-case basis; and this written request does not guarantee approval or an increase in funding.
