

Additional Hybrid Face-to-Face Course Sections Starting September 21

Stevenson Students,

Following the initial pilot phase of 26 courses for face-to-face hybrid instruction this week, the university will be offering an additional 39 course sections for face-to-face hybrid instruction starting Monday, September 21. Students in these classes have been notified by their faculty and have the option of attending the hybrid classes or continuing remote instruction. All classes are being held on the Owings Mills campus or at Owings Mills North.

While Stevenson will continue with a remote instruction option for all classes, the Provost and Deans are working with faculty to identify additional courses for Phase 3 and Phase 4 of face-to-face hybrid instruction. The process will continue to be gradual, based on the considerations of pedagogy, building and classroom density, physical distancing, and monitored for the safety of students and faculty. Students will be notified in advance when hybrid face-to-face instruction becomes available for their courses and sections.
