

Update on COVID-19 Testing for Out-of-State Students

Dear Stevenson Students,

As a follow-up to our August 3rd communication regarding travel advisories and quarantine/testing requirements being issued by various states, we want to let you know of our plan for out-of-state students returning to campus.

Based on a review of Maryland's travel and testing advisory for out-of-state travelers, we will ask out-of-state students who are residents of states with a COVID-19 positivity rating greater than 10% to be tested before returning to campus.

This criteria does not apply to all out-of-state students, only some, so not all out-of-state students will need to be tested. For whom it does apply, the Office of Student Affairs and Wellness Center will reach out to individually next week with instructions on obtaining and submitting their COVID-19 test results before returning to campus this month.

We will notify all our of out-of-state students and families if the guidance from Maryland should change and impact more students.
