

COVID Vaccine Appointments Available to SU Students through LifeBridge Health

Dear Stevenson Students,

LifeBridge Health is now offering Stevenson students registration for COVID vaccination appointments through its website www.lifebridgehealth.org. These vaccinations are free of charge. Per the State of Maryland, students 16 years or older are being given prioritization for vaccines effective April 27.

The registration process is simple:

- Visit www.lifebridgehealth.org and click on the red banner near the top labeled “CLICK HERE TO REQUEST A VACCINE AT A LIFEBRIDGE SITE.”
- Complete the registration form. You should click the button for “General population, including healthy adults age 16 – 64” or “Adults 16-64 at increased risk of severe COVID-19 illness due to comorbidities”, whichever is appropriate to you.
- Indicate “Stevenson University” in the box that says “Employer” on the bottom of the form. This helps LifeBridge identify you as affiliated with Stevenson University either as an SU student or employee so you receive priority scheduling status for the vaccine.
- After you register, LifeBridge will send you an approval email which has a unique vaccination ID number and link that you will click on to schedule your own appointment.
- At the time of your appointment, LifeBridge will administer the Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson vaccine based on availability.

Vaccinations are demonstrating their safety and effectiveness in preventing COVID altogether or limiting its symptoms, and will be critical as we prepare for Stevenson’s full-return to in-person classes, residence life, student activities, and athletics in the Fall. They also help protect your family, friends, and community.
