

Articulation Agreement

Between

McDaniel College

And

Stevenson University

This Articulation Agreement ("Agreement") is made by and between McDaniel College, 2 College Hill, Westminster, MD 21157 and Stevenson University, 1525 Greenspring Valley Road, Stevenson, MD 21153.

WHEREAS McDaniel College and Stevenson University recognize the need and importance of facilitating the transfer of students from Stevenson University to McDaniel College as these students pursue their graduate educational goals, and

WHEREAS McDaniel College and Stevenson University recognize that to enhance this transition, a formal articulation agreement between McDaniel College and Stevenson University should be established, and

WHEREAS McDaniel College and Stevenson University have conducted a thorough review of the curricula for the graduate degree in the Human Services Management Program: Special Education at McDaniel College and for the undergraduate degree in the Counseling & Human Service Program at Stevenson University,

Now, **THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and conditions herein, the adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, McDaniel College and Stevenson University hereby agree as follows:

The following general principles guide the operation of this Agreement:

1. This articulation is designed for graduates of the Stevenson University Counseling & Human Services Program.
2. A maximum of 6 credit hours from Stevenson University will be accepted toward fulfillment of the 30 credit hours required for completion of McDaniel College's graduate degree in Human Services Management.
3. All course credits as delineated in the attached articulation plan will be accepted as transfer to fulfill McDaniel College's requirements for the graduate degree in Human Services Management: Special Education.
4. Only courses in which the student earns a grade of "B" or better are eligible for transfer.

5. Students intending to transfer should complete the admission application for McDaniel College following the sixth semester of their Bachelor Degree program. For preliminary admission into the program, candidates must meet the admission requirements (GPA of 2.70 or greater & background check required by Maryland State law) for the Human Services Management graduate program at McDaniel College and be recommended by Stevenson University. For full admission into the McDaniel College graduate program, candidates must successfully complete all requirements of the undergraduate degree program in Human Services at Stevenson University.
6. McDaniel College and Stevenson University further agree to monitor the performance of this agreement and to revise it as necessary.
7. Appointed institutional representatives at McDaniel College and Stevenson University will insure that appropriate personnel in their respective institution are aware of this agreement, including the admissions and advising staffs, appropriate faculty, and deans.
8. McDaniel College and Stevenson University agree to publicize this agreement. Stevenson University will distribute information regarding this articulation agreement to undergraduate students interested in pursuing a graduate degree in Human Services Management: Special Education.
9. McDaniel College and Stevenson University will conduct an annual review/revision of the procedures and contract.

This agreement becomes effective upon signature by all parties and shall continue in effect unless voided by either party upon sixty (60) days prior written notice. McDaniel College and Stevenson University will consider, in good faith, any amendments proposed by either party; however, the Agreement may only be amended in writing, signed by both parties.

The agreement may be terminated by either party for due cause and after adequate notice to the other.

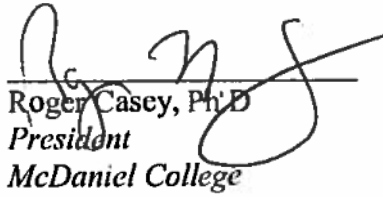

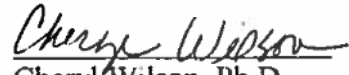
