Executive Summary

Each year, the Career Connection Center leads the collection of "first-destination" data from our graduates. Our purpose is to track the success of our graduates as they head into employment or continuing education. Stevenson has a strong history of success year-over-year. Approximately 94.1% of our undergraduates matriculate to employment or graduate school, which is ahead of regional averages (92.5%) and on par with national averages (94.0%). For the academic year 2021-2022, we have knowledge of 74% of our graduates of our undergraduate and graduate program's first destinations and can report that 94.0% have achieved a positive first-destination outcome.

Examining the data broadly, 69.2% of 2021-2022 Stevenson graduates were working, involved with a service/volunteer program, or in the military and 17.0% were going to graduate school or planning to enroll. Ninety-four percent (94.0%) of Stevenson University graduates were working, going to graduate school or planning to enroll, working as a volunteer or with a service program, or in the military.

Stevenson University graduates are working in fields related to their studies. We asked: "To what extent is your major or area of study at Stevenson related to your current position?" We received 281 responses, of which 262 (93.2%) reported they are working in a field related or somewhat related to their major, or it was unrelated, but they were satisfied.

A breakdown of data for each school in the undergraduate programs is provided below. In addition, the breakdown of the graduate programs is provided separately. The overall data breakdown is provided for each school's graduate programs beginning on page five.

Survey Process

The Career Connection Center collaborates with academic departments to collect post-graduate plans from all Stevenson University students on an annual basis. The list of graduating students is obtained from the Registrar's Office through reports in Informer. The electronic survey, created using Microsoft Forms, is distributed by the Career Connection Center. Outreach is conducted by the Career Connection Center via email to individuals who have applied for graduation prior to graduation. The Career Connection Center also partners with other faculty to identify student outcomes. Professional staff and career peers from the Career Connection Center email and telephone students to personally obtain post-graduation information. When the calls do not culminate in a survey completion, Career Connection staff attempt to connect multiple times via email. When unable to personally connect with a graduate, the information is also retrieved from LinkedIn and Facebook profiles but only if it can be verified with confidence. The complete survey for the 2021-2022 report closed six months after the end of May 2022. Note: due to multiple individuals reporting double majors and rounding, totals can be slightly above or slightly below 100.0%

In 2021-2022, there were 928 graduates from Stevenson University, including Stevenson University Online. Of those 928 students, survey responses for 684 graduates were completed, resulting **in a 74.0% knowledge rate**. The term "knowledge rate" defines the percent of graduates for which the institution has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities.

The total number of undergraduates was 727. Of that number, 538 responded to the survey resulting in a 74.0% knowledge rate. In summary 94.1% were either working *(full and part-time)*, enrolled or planning to enroll in graduate school, participating in a volunteer or service program, or serving in the US Military.
