	Indicator: Percentage of students working part-time (less than 30 hours/week).
Working part-time	Calculation: Number of graduates who reported working part-time, for any reason, divided by the total number of survey respondents.
	How data was collected: Data was collected by the Career Connection Center at Stevenson University by surveying August 2019, December 2019, and May 2020 Stevenson University graduates. Survey closed in November 2020.
	Indicator: Percentage of students enrolled in a program of continuing education.
Enrolled in continuing education	Calculation: Number of graduates who reported they are enrolled in a program of continuing education divided by the total number of survey respondents.
	How data was collected: Data was collected by the Career Connection Center at Stevenson University by surveying August 2019, December 2019, and May 2020 Stevenson University graduates. Survey closed in November 2020.
	Indicator: Percent of graduates for whom the University has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities.
Knowledge rate	Calculation: Number of graduates who responded to the survey, or for whom post-graduation placement information was gathered through faculty, LinkedIn, and other verifiable sources, divided by the total number of graduates who earned a degree during the study period.
