

Accepted Student Profile - Freshmen

Each year Stevenson University receives thousands of applications for admission into our freshman class. Stevenson employs a selective admission process whereby we consider a student's academic transcript including coursework and grades, writing ability, extracurricular and community activities, and letters of recommendation.

For the fall 2023 semester, we received 5,233 applications and admitted 83 percent of those who applied. Below you will find a brief profile for those students who applied and were admitted this year.
