

Transfer Plan Frederick Community College Human Services Area of Concentration

This transfer plan is intended for students pursuing Human Services Area of Concentration within the A.A. in Social Sciences at Frederick Community College who are interested in pursuing a B. S. in Counseling & Human Services at Stevenson University. The equivalencies below demonstrate how a student can meet both the requirements of the associate degree and prepare for a seamless transfer to Stevenson. Stevenson participates in reverse transfer should students transfer after completing 15 credits at Frederick but before completing the full associate's degree. Any student who enters Stevenson with an A.A. or A.S. degree will have completed all general education requirements. Please note:

- Only courses that have course equivalencies are displayed. This guide does not show all transferable courses from this college. It also does not display all Stevenson University courses that will fulfill a specific requirement.
- Program requirements must be completed with a grade of C or better, and general education courses must be passed with a grade of D or better.
- Stevenson University will accept up to 70 credits from 2-year institutions. Up to 90 credits can be
 applied to degree requirements from a combination of 2-year institutions, 4-year institutions, and nondirect classroom instruction (including CLEP, AP, and other nationally recognized standardized
